



## Digital Creations Competition 2026 Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Just2easy and COBIS Digital Creations Competition is open to COBIS schools (including Applicant Schools). Each school with a registered COBIS account should participate as an individual school. A small group of non-COBIS member schools are eligible to partake in this competition, but this is by invitation only.
- As a business based in the UK, Just2easy is following the UK government policy of services exports ban to Russia. Therefore, presently we are unable to offer schools based in Russia access to the Just2easy and COBIS Digital Creations Competition.
- 3. Schools may only submit competition entries from bona fide students at their school.
- 4. Each animation or game should be created by an individual student, not a group of students.
- 5. The closing date for registrations will be 12th December 2025 at 23:59.
- 6. The closing date for entry submission with be 5th March 2026 at 23:59.
- 7. Entries must be submitted by a teacher on behalf of the student to the Just2easy and COBIS Digital Creations Competition page on the Just2easy website (<u>just2easy.com/cobis-time-travel-competition</u>) via an online entry form.
- 8. All entries will be submitted, processed and judged via the Just2easy platform. Please read the Just2easy <u>Privacy Policy</u> before entering the competition for more information on how Just2easy will process your data.
- 9. All teachers should have the correct permissions from students and/or parents/guardians to share their students' names and ages as part of this competition.
- 10. There are three categories for submitted entries:
  - · Reception and Year 1: paint with JIT paint
  - Years 2, 3, and 4: animation with JIT animate
  - Years 5 and 6: coding with j2visual

Please ensure entries are submitted for the correct category. Entries will not be accepted from students outside of these categories or for work submitted to the wrong category.

- 11. Three entries per category per school may be submitted (total maximum of 9 entries per school). Schools must complete their own internal judging to decide on which entries to submit. Just2easy will accept the first three entries from a school in each category and reserves the right to exclude subsequent submissions from the judging process.
- 12. The theme of the Digital Creations competition is *COBIS Adventures in time travel*. Just2easy reserves the right to exclude any entries which do not adhere to this theme.
- 13. Entries must be the students' own work.
- 14. Any foul play, cheating, plagiarism or attempted manipulation of the results will result in a permanent exclusion of the offending school from this competition. The judgement of COBIS and/or Just2easy on this point will be final.







- 15. The judges' decision regarding the winners of the Just2easy and COBIS Digital Creations Competition will be final.
- The winning students and schools will be announced in April 2026. The winning schools will be notified by email
- 17. The full name, age, school name and entry of winners and runners-up will be published on the COBIS and Just2easy website and social media. This information may also be published and promoted at the COBIS Annual Conference in 2026 and in other COBIS or Just2easy related publications. By entering the competition, the teacher confirms that the necessary permissions have been sought from students and/or their parents to publish this information for such purposes.
